### June 3 - July 24: ART AFRICA

Curator: Mahnaz Motevalli - Handmade baskets, jewelry and art from Kampala, Uganda benefiting the Makerere University - Johns Hopkins University Research Collaboration for families infected and affected by HIV/AIDS. Additional African tribal sculptures, masks, baskets and jewelry are assembled by the Queen St. Gallery in Martinsburg, WV

Curator: Tom Nebel - Original watercolors, pastels, oils and other 2-D work exhibited by 20 juried members of the Potomac River Artist Guild.

Curator: Sandy Kay - Décor changes, passions evolve. In a community of artists and collectors it's always time for something new - and sharing something ageless. Recycled jewelry and art is donated to the Morgan Arts Council, showcased and offered for sale.

### March 3 - April 2: YOUTH ART SHOW

Curator: Anna Ruggiero - Students from all Morgan County schools plus homeschoolers present art they make during the year. A recital of local students opens the show.

### April 14 - May 28: KEEP ME IN STITCHES

Curator: Mickey Seiko & Sue Kipp - The local Delectable Mountains Quilters showcase work done in new innovative techniques as well as classical ones in this annual show. Items range from full-size quilts to wearable items and home décor. Classes on techniques taught by quilt group members are offered throughout the show period.

April 8 & 9: Preview of Yard Square Quilts

### June 2 - July 16: FORGED!

Metals hot-shaped with fire, hammer and anvil from more than a dozen regional artists are featured including functional and decorative works, using modern and traditional techniques. A "Hammer In" is planned in the Ice House Cultural Park, date to be announced.
