PORTAL/THRESHOLD GALLERY EXHIBIT OPENS JULY 31 IN BERKELEY SPRINGS

BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV—The Morgan Arts Council presents a new exhibit, “Portal/Threshold,” in the Ice House Gallery, July 31-September 20. A meet-the-artists reception opens the show on Friday, July 31 at 7:30 p.m.

Luc Fiedler curates this show featuring the works of 10 artists, including a metal forger, mixed media artists, painters and sculptors. The artwork reflects impressions around transitions. Some works are simple and direct, while other pieces are introspective and challenging.

“Each artwork reflects not only the artist’s craft, but also their personality, humor and perspective on our world,” said Fiedler.

Also opening July 31 in the Hall of Dreams and Carr-Kelly Galleries are “My Back Yard Birds,” with photography from Doug Ritenburg, and “Capturing the Light,” an exhibit of paintings by award-winning watercolorist Lynn Ferris. Both shows run through September 20 in the galleries on the first and second floors of the Ice House.

Funding for these exhibits comes in part from the National Endowment for the Arts, the West Virginia Commission on the Arts and local hotel/motel taxes.

The Ice House is at the corner of Independence and Mercer Streets in downtown Berkeley Springs, WV. Gallery hours are Monday and Thursday, 1-5 p.m. and Friday, Saturday and Sunday, 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. through December.
