#### BLUES BAND ROUNDS OUT SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV—Energy runs high as Baltimore’s Kelly Bell Band brings blues to Berkeley Springs State Park on Saturday, August 19, in the final performance for this summer’s Concerts in the Park series from the Morgan Arts Council.

Voted the Best Blues Band in the Mid-Atlantic Region 12 years in a row, the band, known for phat blues, combines elements of hip-hop, funk, and electrified blues, for a sound that reflects the way blues is moving today.

Formed as a backup band for Bo Diddley, the Kelly Bell Band has been playing and recording for 20 years. Their genre-expanding sound makes you think of every blues band and performer you know—and then they take it one step further.

The concert starts at 5:30 p.m. The Ice House, corner of Independence and Mercer, two blocks north of the park, serves as the rain location.
