

RUNA Brings Celtic Music to Berkeley Springs State Park

BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV—Traditional music is redefined as RUNA, an internationally acclaimed five-piece band, brings its own brand of Celtic sounds to Berkeley Springs State Park in Morgan Arts Council's Summer Concerts in the Park, Saturday, August 5.

RUNA has earned a reputation as one of the most innovative Irish folk groups of this generation. The band, with members hailing from Ireland, Canada and the U.S., has been playing together for nearly a decade. RUNA weaves the haunting melodies and exuberant tunes of Ireland and Scotland with the lush harmonies and intoxicating rhythms of jazz, bluegrass, flamenco and blues.

All concerts start at 5:30 p.m. The Ice House, corner of Independence and Mercer, two blocks north of the park, serves as the rain location.
