## BLUES BAND RETURNS TO SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV— Baltimore’s Kelly Bell Band brings blues to Berkeley Springs State Park on Saturday, July 21, for the 2018 Morgan Arts Council. Summer Concerts in the Park series.

Voted the Best Blues Band in the Mid-Atlantic Region 12 years in a row, the band, known for phat blues, combines elements of hip-hop, funk, and electrified blues, for a sound that reflects the way blues is moving today.

Formed as a backup band for Bo Diddley, the Kelly Bell Band has been playing and recording for 20 years. Their genre-expanding sound makes you think of every blues band and performer you know—and then they take it one step further.

Kelly Bell is another “rained out” group from last year whose music is too good to pass up for a return visit.

The concert starts at 5:30 p.m. The Ice House, corner of Independence and Mercer, two blocks north of the park, serves as the rain location.
