#### ACAPPELLA AMERICANA MUSIC TO BE PRESENTED AT THE PARK

BERKELEY SPRINGS, WV—Morgan Arts Council's Summer Concerts in the Park presents Bare Bones Saturday, August 11.

Bare Bones, an acappella trio that performs American roots music ranging from old-time to rhythm and blues to rousing old gospel songs. Their song list is varied, showcasing traditional songs dating back several centuries to contemporary songs, always with the distinctive sound that comes from unaccompanied singing rooted in Appalachia. Their great love is American vernacular music, its roots and offshoots, and they rock it all.

Becky Kimmons, Bill Kimmons and Mark Davis, singing as Bare Bones, have sent chills up and down spines all around the world with their acappella harmonies via Public Radio International's Mountain Stage, and live, in person, and on many concert stages.

All concerts start at 5:30 p.m. The Ice House, corner of Independence and Mercer, two blocks north of the park, serves as the rain location.
